SUBJECT: Weed Army Community Hospital (WACH), Fort Irwin – Health Service Areas

1. References.

2. Purpose. To define the Health Service Areas (HSAs) for Weed Army Community Hospital, Fort Irwin which includes medical/dental and public health services. WACH will be responsible for providing all clinical and administrative outpatient services and public health services only within established boundaries. HSAs assigned to WACH are outlined as a geographical area of responsibility. Dental and public health HSAs are aligned under the MTF.

3. Fort Irwin Health Service Area.

- a. U.S. Army MTFs:
 - i. MEDDAC (W4FFAA), Weed Army Community Hospital, Fort Irwin, CA

4. Geographical Area of Responsibility.

- a. WACH's HSAs consist of the four southern California counties (Imperial, Riverside, San Bernardino, and San Diego), all counties in the state of Idaho, and all counties in the state of Nevada.
